2. Access the shared URL and QR code

2. Access the shared URL and QR code

Once translation begins, the screen will display the following:



3. Select a language

Tap the language name at the bottom of the screen to bring up a list of languages. Select the language you want to translate to.



4. Display only my language

Tap the  at the bottom of the screen, and then tap "Display only my language" to show only the translated text in your selected language.



5. Listen to the audio

Connect your headphones to your device, and press the  at the bottom of the screen to hear the translated words. Press the  to stop the audio.

6. Change text size


You can change the text size using the slider in the button  at the bottom of the screen.



7. Screen during break time


"Sharing has stopped" will appear on the screen. Press "OK", and the message "Sharing inactive" will appear.

When the teacher resumes sharing, the translated words will appear again.



8. Screen after sharing is resumed

The message "Sharing has resumed" will appear on the screen. When you press "OK", the translated words will appear again.


